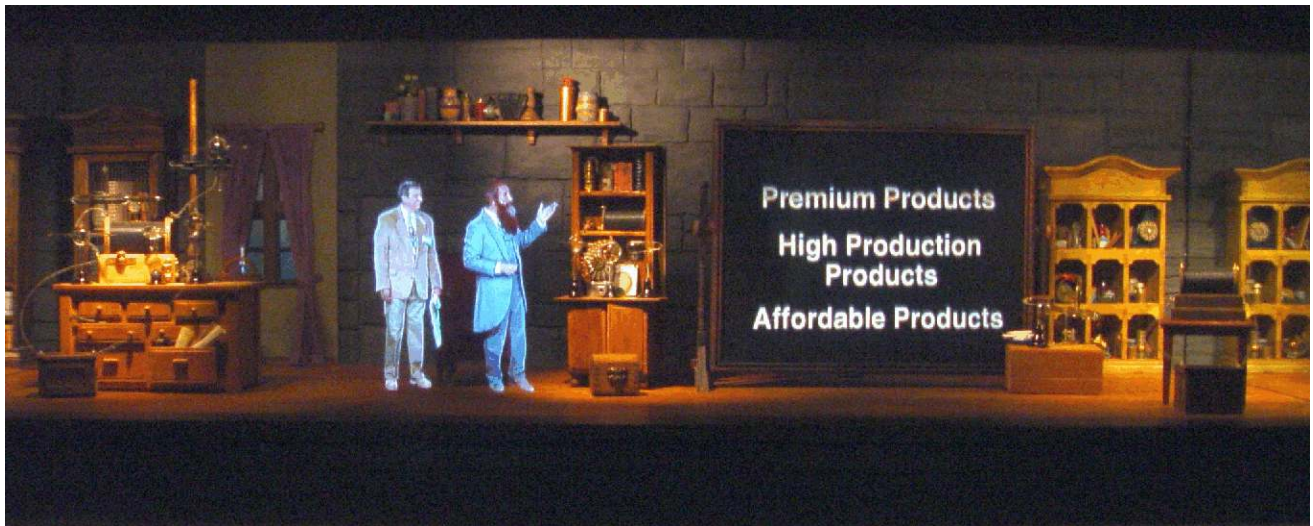


Spectral Imagery

Roentgen first appeared for FUJI in 1990 and returned in 2002 to update attendees on the company's products and technology.
